#### **Main Functions and Activities**

### **Packaging Operations**

- Loading of glass manually and automatically.
- Monitoring of automated application of wire muselets, capsules & screw caps onto bottles and loading of same into application machines.
- Manual application of the above if required.
- Visual monitoring of all products.
- Monitoring and assisting automated packaging of product into cartons & manual packing if required.
- Manual stacking of finished product on pallets for shipping or storage if required.
- Rework of damaged products as required.
- Component preparation as required.

**Measures** - All activities completed in accordance with company policies and procedures. Target less that 1% wastage. Target less than 1% inaccuracy in production of finished product. Rework of product at 0%.

#### **Hygiene & Quality**

- Ensure that no product is packaged with faults.
- Report all quality issues to your Supervisor.

**Measures** - Target 100% quality product, meeting required production specifications with nil returns due to line related contamination.
